ORDINANCE**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 501
REGARDING THE OGEMA TOWNSHIP PLANNING COMMISSION**

The board of supervisors of the Town of Ogema ordains as follows:

Article 1. Section II of Ordinance No. 501 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Subdivision 1. Membership.

The planning commission shall consist of at least three members appointed by the Town Board. Because interest in serving on the planning commission varies, the Town Board will by motion indicate if the number of planning commission members will exceed three and then shall act to appoint the additional member or members. The Town Board may appoint its zoning administrator to the planning commission and, if so appointed, the zoning administrator shall have full voting rights as a member.

Subdivision 2. Terms.

Terms of office for members of the planning commission shall be for three years. There are no limits on the number of terms a member may serve. The term of office shall commence on the date of appointment by the Town Board and terms shall expire on April 1st. The Town Board shall fill any vacancies on the planning commission by appointment. Any member of the planning commission can be removed at any time by a majority vote of the Town Board.


Article 2. This ordinance shall be effective upon the first day of publication after adoption.
